The Board of Trustees of the University System of New Hampshire invites nominations and expressions of interest for the position of President of the University of New Hampshire.

Founded in 1866, the University of New Hampshire is a top-tier land-, sea-, and space-grant public university, serving more than 10,000 undergraduates and 2,000 graduate students. Recognized as a rising star among research universities, the University retains the atmosphere of a New England liberal arts college with a faculty dedicated to undergraduate teaching.

A spirit of discovery naturally informs the curricula, encouraging students to pursue their interests across disciplinary lines. Within its seven schools and colleges, the University offers 2,000 courses in more than 100 majors, a stimulating honors program, and a wide range of opportunities for internships, study abroad, and national exchange experiences. Participation in research is a keystone of the undergraduate experience.

As the leader and chief administrator of the University, the President exercises broad executive powers over all aspects of the instructional, research, creative artistry, and public service functions of the institution. The President reports to the Chancellor of the University System, serves as a colleague to the other presidents in the System, and is a member of the Board of Trustees. The president will lead the campus community to further develop and play a principal role in the articulation of a compelling vision of public higher education for both the University and the State of New Hampshire.

Preference will be given to candidates with appropriate terminal degrees, demonstrated management and interpersonal skills, teaching, scholarship, and higher education achievements. Desirable qualifications include demonstrated leadership skills, the ability to develop and articulate strategic plans, and an interest and effectiveness in working in a collaborative environment.
