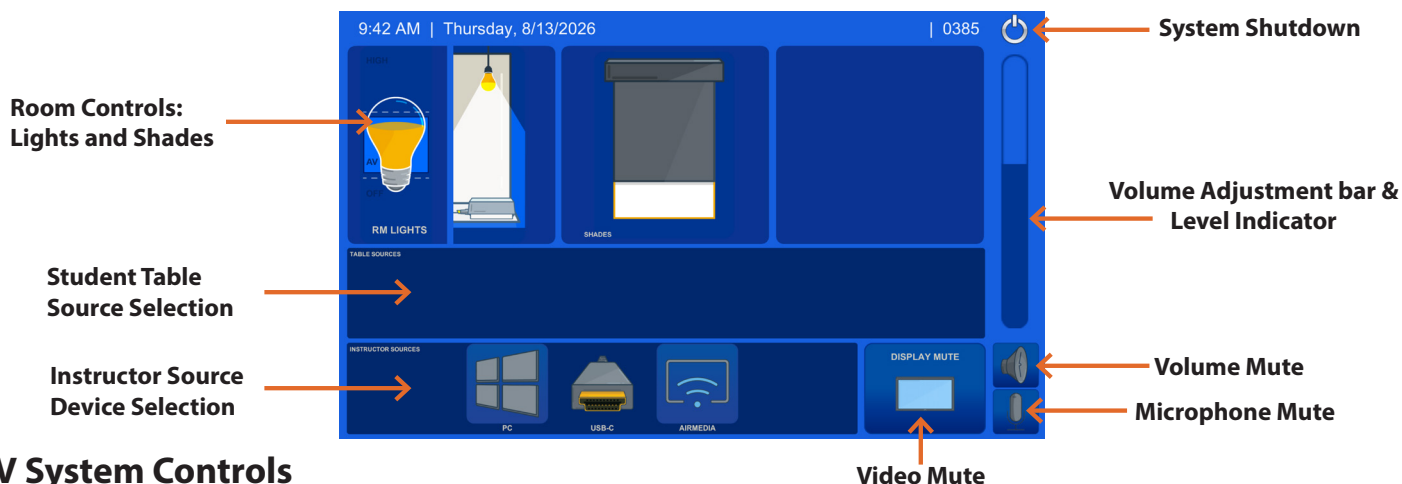




Hamilton Smith T.E.A.L. Classrooms

The audiovisual system in this room has been designed around the Technology Enhanced Active Learning principle which allows student groups to connect and share content with the class.



AV System Controls

Use the AV system in this classroom to project from a variety of sources including a **USB-C** connection, wireless **AirMedia**, or installed **Windows** computer.

The main source bar located at the bottom of the AV touch panel contains all devices and connections located at the instructor podium. The student table source bar is located right above this, and will populate with a source icon for each student table when a device is connected.

Touch to wake up the AV Touch Panel.

Connect the provided **USB-C cable** to your device or select your source device (*installed PC or AirMedia*).

If the source device is powered on and awake, the AV system will turn on.

Your projection image will appear within 60 seconds.

Note: USB-C connection in this space **DOES provide laptop power.*

To connect to the **AirMedia** wireless presentation, select the AirMedia source on the AV Touch Panel and follow the projected instructions.

Windows Device: Use the  +  to launch the Casting Menu, select the associated room, and enter the code.

MacOS Device: Use the  to access the  , select the associated room, enter the code, choose Mirror Display.

After selecting an instructor or student table source, the AV touch panel will display a menu with three modes for displaying the content:

INSTRUCTOR - sends selected source to instructor podium monitor only

MAIN DISPLAY - sends selected source to the main room display (*4 large displays above instructor space*)

ALL DISPLAYS - sends selected source to the main display, and all student table displays

The last source selected by the instructor will be the source that is sending audio to the room speakers.

Each student table in this room has a USB-C connection within the recessed table pod. When a student connects their device to the provided USB-C cable that system will detect the device and begin displaying at that table station.



When finished, select **System Shutdown** on the AV touch panel.
