## HERD SUPERVISOR\*

### **Function Job:**

Under general supervision of designated supervisor, to be responsible for the care and management of livestock.

## **Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Supervise and be responsible for the care/feeding of livestock, as assigned.
- 2. Make recommendations on livestock to be sold and/or purchased.
- 3. Supervise breeding of livestock by natural or artificial means.
- 4. Be responsible for cleaning of animals and sterilization of bars, stalls and equipment.
- 5. Compute feed/formulas and mix feed to obtain desired results.
- 6. Provide veterinary care as needed or secure services of veterinarian for more serious cases.
- 7. Select herd grazing pastures or operate forage to feeders.
- 8. Be responsible for the maintenance of mechanical equipment, such as milking machines.
- 9. Maintain necessary records.
- 10. Hire, supervise and assign work to staff and/or student workers, as assigned.
- 11. Perform other related duties, as assigned.

# **Minimum Acceptable Qualifications:**

- 1. High school graduation or equivalent and six years experience in livestock work and/or livestock management <u>or</u> equivalent combination of vocational training in agriculture and experience in livestock work.
- 2. Knowledge of the care of livestock.
- 3. Ability to diagnose common diseases in livestock.
- 4. Supervisory ability.

### **Additional Desirable Qualifications:**

1. Experience in livestock work gained through employment at institution to be served.
