

PHYSICIAN*

Function of Job:

Under administrative review of responsible Health Professional, to examine, diagnose and treat students in need of remedial and/or preventive medical care.

Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Examine students to determine nature and extent of illness.
2. Order or execute various tests, analyses and x-rays to provide information on student's condition.
3. Analyze reports/findings of examination/tests and diagnose condition.
4. Administer and prescribe treatments and drugs, as necessary.
5. Advise students concerning diet, hygiene and methods for prevention of disease.
6. Inoculate and vaccinate students to immunize them from communicable diseases.
7. Engage in research and aid in the control/cure of disease.
8. Counsel students on family planning and contraceptive devices/methods.
9. Guide and counsel students in minor emotional problems and where applicable, refer them to psychiatrist or other specialist.
10. May supervise assisting nurses, technicians or other assigned medical or office staff.
11. Maintain current knowledge on latest medical research, techniques and treatments.
12. Perform other related duties, as directed.

Minimum Acceptable Qualifications:

1. Doctor of Medicine degree and satisfactory completion of a medical internship.
2. Possession of current license to practice medicine in the state of New Hampshire.
3. Good communication skills, both oral and written.
