

## POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCH ASSOCIATE\*

### **Function of Job:**

Under direction of designated faculty or senior staff member, to perform research in field of specialization.

### **Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Work with faculty member in performing independent research in particular area of specialized study, as assigned.
2. Prepare articles of a scholarly nature for publication.
3. Advise and assist doctoral candidates in their research projects.
4. Perform related duties, as assigned.

### **Minimum Acceptable Qualifications:**

1. Doctorate or equivalent professional degree.
2. Ability to perform independent research.
3. Knowledge of literature in field of specialization.

**Note:** Persons in this classification are postdoctoral students who are hired on a temporary basis rather than on permanent status usually for one or two years.
