B. Suspend 25% Enrollment Limitation of Out-of-State Undergraduates at UNH

MOVED, on recommendation of Elizabeth Chilton, President of the University of New Hampshire, the Financial Affairs Committee recommends that the Board of Trustees suspend for FY26 the limitation of 25 percent imposed by state statute RSA 187-A:10 on the number of undergraduate students enrolled at UNH from domiciles outside the state, it having been determined that such suspension benefits the state and UNH without impairing the opportunity for qualified students of the state of New Hampshire to attend UNH.
