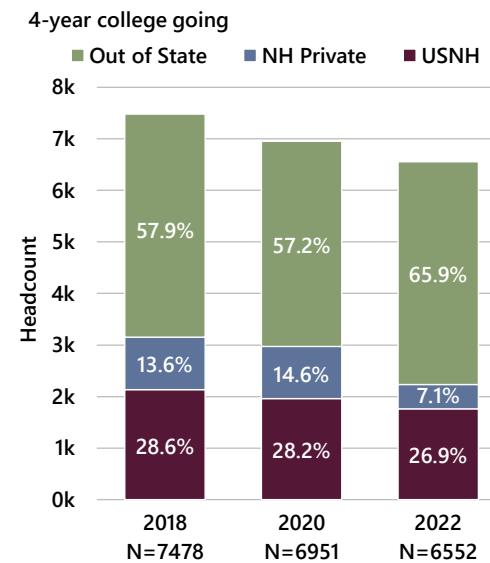

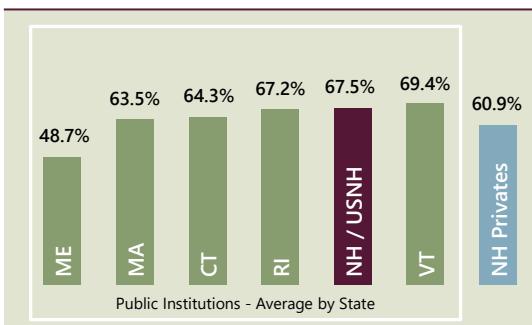

## Bachelor's 6-Year Graduation Rate



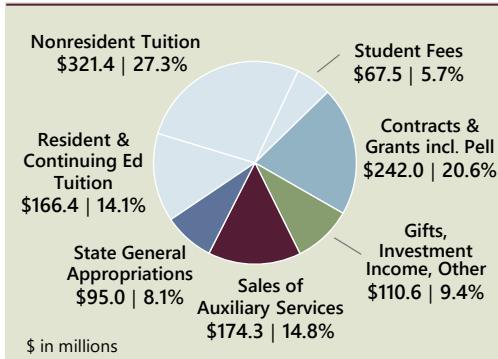

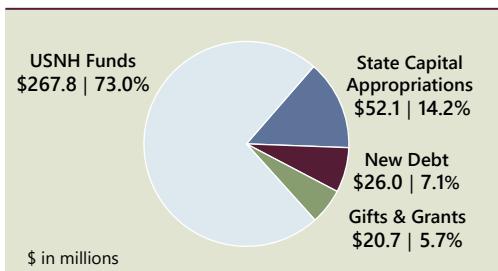

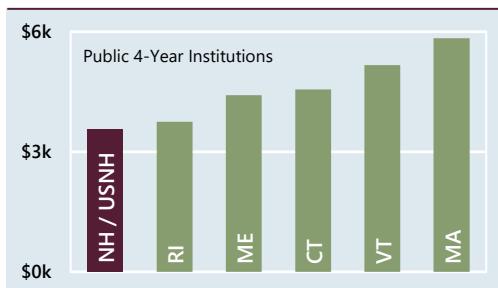
